



Public Notice on Extension of Time to Make a Decision on the Proposed Timaru District Plan

Schedule 1 Clause 10A of the Resource Management Act 1991

Date of public notice: 17 October 2024

The Minister for the Environment has granted Timaru District Council an 18 month extension of time to give a decision on the Proposed Timaru District Plan (PTDP), under clause 10A Schedule 1 of the Resource management Act.

This means that the decision date has been extended to 22 March 2026.

The reasons for the Minister's decision are:

- a. Timaru District Council has met the statutory requirements for an application under clause 10A, Schedule 1 of the Resource Management Act 1991.
- b. Timaru District Council has advised that an extension until 22 March 2026 is needed to complete the hearing of submissions and issues a decision on the PTDP.
- c. Granting an extension to Timaru District council for the PTDP until 22 March 2026 will provide procedural certainty for the community and all parties in the remainder of the plan-change process.
