



Public Notice of Application for Renewal with Club Licence

Section 101, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Fairlie Golf Club Incorporated has made application to the Mackenzie District Licensing Committee for the renewal with variation of conditions of a Club Licence in respect of the premises situated at 34 Talbot Road, Fairlie and known as the "Fairlie Golf Club".

The general nature of the business conducted (or to be conducted) under the licence is that of a club.

The days on which and the hours during which alcohol is (or is intended to be) sold under the licence are:

CLUB LICENCE: Monday to Thursday - 10.00am to 10.00pm (extended to 11.00pm during the period of daylight saving)

Friday to Sunday and Public Holidays - 10.00am to 1.00am the following day

The application may be inspected during ordinary office hours at the office of the Mackenzie District Licensing Committee at 2 King George Place, Timaru.

Any person who is entitled to object and who wishes to object to the issue of the licence may, not later than 25 working days after the date of the publication of this notice, being the deadline of 16 August 2024. The objector is to file a notice in writing of the objection with the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee at Timaru District Council, PO Box 522, Timaru 7940.

No objection to the issue of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
