The above landowners wish to support the proposed plan for the following reasons;

- 1. The lots referred to are situated within an existing rural village and bounder the Woodbury Domain, a large recreational area, and one bounders the Woodbury Café, the centre of Woodbury.
- 2. The demand for building sites is strong. Any Woodbury residential property put on the market recently has sold within days.
- 3. We the present owners, feel very comfortable subdivision into minimum 5000 sq m sections will not compromise the existing character and qualities of the area. All three lots are well planted with trees and ornamentals already.
- 4. After submitting two submissions and attending a hearing requesting a change of zoning from Rural One, it was recommended our case was to be "Accepted". This was then passed (adopted) by Timaru District Council on 22 May 2018. Quite sometime later we were informed this decision had been reversed. On questioning "why", the answer was "water". We have recently been informed the new treatment plant and storage facility for the Te Moana scheme at Pleasant Valley will mean new connections are made available. It was pleasing to hear a reticulated water supply will now be possible as we are aware this is a requirement under the Rural Lifestyle Zone.
- 5. All land involved in this submission is very well drained hence modern sewage/greywater disposal units work efficiently.

We have read and feel comfortable with the regulations set out for RLZ and would expect new owners to comply accordingly.
