

Public Notice of Application for Renewal with Club Licence

Section 101, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pleasant Point Rugby Football Club Incorporated has made application to the Timaru District Licensing Committee for the renewal of a Club Licence in respect of the premises situated at Pleasant Point Domain, Main Road, Pleasant Point and known as the "Pleasant Point Rugby Football Club".

The general nature of the business conducted (or to be conducted) under the licence is that of a club.

The days on which and the hours during which alcohol is (or is intended to be) sold under the licence are:

 Saturdays and Public Holidays – 3.00pm to 12.00 midnight
 Sundays – 11.00am to 10.00pm

The application may be inspected during ordinary office hours at the office of the Timaru District Licensing Committee at 2 King George Place, Timaru.

Any person who is entitled to object and who wishes to object to the issue of the licence may, not later than 25 working days after the date of the publication of this notice, being the deadline of 20th day of July 2024. The objector is to file a notice in writing of the objection with the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee at Timaru District Council, PO Box 522, Timaru 7940.

No objection to the issue of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
