Within your planning maps, and online GIS mapping system I wish to propose an amendment to the placement of the:

- 1 SASM20 line
- 2 Esplanade provision line
- 3 Public access provision line

Which currently run through either the middle of the Hae Hae Te Moana river or on steep and relatively inaccessible land including our property at 1986 Te Moana Road.

I suggest that these mapping lines should be placed through the Four Peaks Esplanade Reserve owned by the Timaru District Council.

Attached are maps showing the current line placement and with a new line placement (blue).

The placement of the new line makes logical sense from a topography point of view, and it is my understanding that the reserve has been set aside for the reason of public and mana whenua access.


