[1] The Timaru District Council ("the Council") appointed Cindy Robinson (Chairperson), Ros Day-Cleavin, Councillor Stacey Scott, Jane Whyte, Megen McKay, and Raewyn Solomon ("the panel") to hear submissions and further submissions, and evidence to make decisions on the Timaru Proposed District Plan ("the Proposed Plan") pursuant to Section 34A(1) of the Resource Management Act 1991 ("RMA"). Our delegation includes all related procedural powers to conduct those hearings.

2. MEMORANDUM OF DAVID WILLIAM COLLINS

- [3] By way of a Memorandum dated 23 June 2024, Mr Collins outlines concerns regarding the section 42A officers recomendations that the submissions relating to the requsted rezoning of Blanswood and associated consequential amendments be transferred to the Open Space Zone topic hearing.
- [4] Mr Collin's view is that this is incorrect, as none of the submissions relating to Blandswood request re-zoning to anything but the Settlement Zone, and there no jurisdictional scope provided in the submissions to amend the provisions of any other zones.

[5] We direct the s42A author to respond to the panel on the issues raised in Mr Collins memorandum by Monday 1 July 2024, and to clarify what hearing this submission is allocated to.
